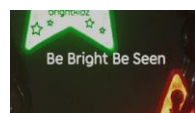

Darker Days and Darker Nights!

With the clocks due to go back on Sunday 30th October 2022 and Autumn nights getting closer it is important that your children understand Road Safety and how to stay Safe and Visible in the dark.

ROAD Wise Be ROAD wise - help keep your child by teaching them 'The Green Cross Code' - [Green cross code](#) - [Roadwise](#) – Children Should not be allowed out alone or with friends (peers) until they know their Green cross code.



Be bright and be seen – In the Autumn months it gets a lot darker from much earlier. Road users find it much harder to see pedestrians in the dark especially when they are wearing dark colours.
